## NEB & Officers Election Voting Instructions

Dear Member;

Please find enclosed an official ballot, a small envelope marked 'OFFICIAL BALLOT', a postage-paid self-addressed envelope and Candidates' campaign materials.

For more information on the candidates, visit the [cusw.ca](http://cusw.ca) homepage and click on the "2020 Elections" link. In this section, you'll find a list of candidates you can read up on to inform your vote.

### Voting instructions:

1. Place an 'X' beside **1** candidate **ONLY** in the boxes marked 'PRESIDENT' and 'TREASURER'

Place an 'X' beside **3** candidates **ONLY** in the box marked 'NATIONAL EXECUTIVE BOARD MEMBERS'

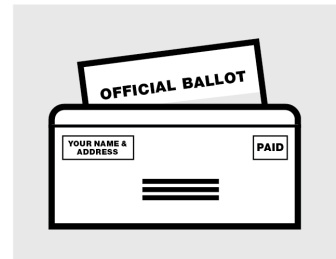
Place an 'X' beside **2** candidates **ONLY** in the box marked 'VICE PRESIDENT'

2. Place your ballot inside the envelope marked 'OFFICIAL BALLOT', then place that envelope inside the postage-paid envelope, *write your name and address in the space provided*, seal and put in the mail.

### Important Information:

- Be sure to place your name and address on the top left corner of the stamped, self-addressed envelope. Failure to place your name and address will result in your ballot not being counted.
- The self-addressed envelopes are numbered for ease of counting. Your name and address are **ONLY** needed on the self-addressed envelope to confirm that you are an eligible voter on the voting list and cannot be used to identify how you voted.
- Ballots must be received at the Post Office Box by **Thursday, June 25th, 2020**. *Any ballot received after June 25th is void.* Ballots will be collected from the Post Office Box on June 25th. The ballot count will be conducted at the Union Office on June 26th.
- Candidates can appoint a scrutinizer to observe the counting of the ballots. The Election Judge will decide on the eligibility of any contested ballot and his/her decision shall be final and binding.
